# Bone Grafting: Ridge Augmentation & Socket Preservation with Bone Grafting for Future Implant Placement

Up to Two Live Demo Surgeries and Hands On Surgeries in Simulation (Animal Mandibles)

LIMITED ENROLMENT

with Dr. Tassos Irinakis and Dr. Ali Sadeghi of the West Coast Institute

This 2-day course is designed to teach dentists the procedure of lateral ridge augmentation via guided bone regeneration. Bone healing patterns, grafting materials & membranes, indications & management of complications will be addressed in detail. Atraumatic Extraction and Socket Preservation with bone grafting will also be addressed in detail.

Participants will learn about the role soft tissue grafting has in assisting bone grafting and improving the esthetics of implant cases. Treatment planning of participants' cases will be discussed if such cases are brought to the mentors by the dentists. Suturing techniques will also be demonstrated.

There will be 1-2 LIVE demo surgeries performed on patients by the course mentor(s). All dentists will perform hands-on surgeries in simulation on animal mandibles.

Participants will practice Atraumatic Extraction (with periostomes), Socket Preservation (with or without bone grafting), Lateral Ridge Augmentation in single site cases with the use of bone substitutes and the appropriate suturing techniques. At the completion of this course, dentists will:

- Understand the methodology and rationale for Atraumatic Extraction & Socket Preservation
- Understand the methodology & rationale for single site Lateral Ridge Augmentation and their limitations on this procedure
- Develop diagnostic protocols to recognize uncomplicated from complicated cases and the different treatment planning strategy required
- Manage postoperative phase and potential complications.



**TASSOS IRINAKIS DDS, MSC, DIP. PERIO, FRCD(C)** is a Certified Specialist in Periodontics and one of the current leaders in comprehensive implant patient care and implant education for dental professionals. He served as the Director of the Graduate Periodontics & Implant Surgery program at the University of British Columbia for nearly a decade. Dr. Irinakis is an Associate Clinical Professor in the faculty of dentistry and has published several articles on implants and bone grafting in peer reviewed journals. He has lectured nationally and internationally and holds two private practices in Vancouver and Courtenay, BC.



**ALI SADEGHI DMD, MD, FRCD(C)** is a board-certified Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon. He obtained his Doctorate of Medicine degree from Mount Sinai School of Medicine in New York City as part of his 6-year oral and maxillofacial residency training in the same hospital. He is currently the Department Head of Dentistry and Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery at Lions Gate hospital in North Vancouver and Assistant Clinical Professor at UBC Dentistry. Dr. Sadeghi lectures nationally

and internationally on all aspects of Implant Surgery and has private practices in Vancouver and Port Coquitlam, BC.
